GENERAL INFORMATION

Program

The Fortieth Annual Meeting includes a preconference workshop, three invited addresses, the Presidential Address, two Early Career Award presentations, eighteen symposia, special interest lunches and dinners, and four poster sessions. The schedule is summarized on the inside back cover.

Registration

Registration will be held in the Lobby of the US Grant Hotel on Wednesday from 4:00 PM-8:00 PM, and Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 8:30-11:30AM and from 1:00-4:00 PM.

Poster Sessions

Poster sessions will be held in the Crystal Room and Pavillion Ballroom, at 8:00-10:00 PM on Thursday, 4:30-6:30 PM on Friday, 7:30-9:30 PM on Saturday, and 8:00-10:00 AM on Sunday. At least one author should remain with each poster throughout the poster sessions. Handouts should be available for each poster. Posters should be set up between 10:30 AM and 2:00 PM for the Thursday, Friday, and Saturday poster sessions. Posters for the Sunday Session can be set up immediately following the Saturday poster session. Posters on Thursday and Friday, may be left up until 10:00 AM the next day. Posters on Saturday should be removed immediately following the poster session so that the Sunday presenters can set up their posters.

Transportation

Air:

Most attendees will fly into San Diego International Airport, located five minutes from the downtown area. Ground transportation can be accessed on the ground level of the main terminal. Attendees may take the complimentary shuttle bus to the hotel. Cabs are also available at the airport on the ground level of the main terminal. The approximate cost is \$8 one-way.

Car:

When leaving the airport keep in the right hand lane; exit Downtown/Harbor Drive; continue onto Harbor Drive to Broadway. Turn left onto Broadway; go ten blocks to 3rd Avenue; turn left onto 3rd Avenue. U.S. Grant Hotel is on the right. Turn right into the hotel entrance.
